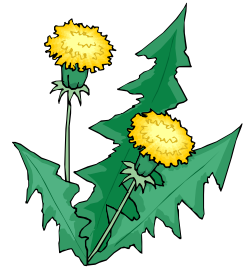




# Wildflower Habitats
